Section 1 – Laeliinae Hybrids

(Classes A to D consisting of all hybrids from the Sub-tribe *Laeliinae*)

Class A – 125mm and over – Any colour or combination of colours

Class B – 75 mm to less than 125mm – Any colour or combination of colours

Class C – Miniatures less than 75 mm - Any colour or combination of colours

Class D – Cluster Types – minimum of 5 open flowers

Section 2 – Dendrobium Hybrids (excluding Section 8)

Class A – Phalaenanthe Type

Class B – Ekapol ($\frac{3}{4}$ Phalaenanthe Shape)

Class C – Intermediate Type ($\frac{1}{2}$ Phalaenanthe Shape)

Class D – Spathulata Type – less than 60 mm natural spread (includes Den. *carronii* & *canaliculatum* influence)

Class E – Spathulata Type – 60mm and over (includes Den. *carronii* & *canaliculatum* influence)

Class F – Any other *Dendrobium* Hybrid

Champion Dendrobium Hybrid

Section 3 – Aeridinae Hybrid (excluding Sections 4 and 8)

Class A – *Vanda* – 65mm and over

Class B – *Vanda* – under 65mm

Class C – Intergeneric hybrid – 65mm and over

Class D – Intergeneric hybrid – under 65mm

Class E – Any other *Aeridinae* hybrid

Champion Aeridinae Hybrid

Section 4 – *Phalaenopsis* Hybrids (excluding Section 8)

(*Doritaenopsis* now included with *Phalaenopsis*)

Class A – Any colour without markings

Class B – Any colour with dominant stripes or spotting

Class C – Non-classic Type – Any colour with dominate stripes or spotting, excluding Class E

Class D – Non-classic Type – Any colour without dominant markings, excluding Class E

Class E – Miniature – Any type less than 60mm

Section 5 – *Oncidiinae* Hybrids

Class A – *Oncidiinae* – “Dancing Lady” or “Varicosum” Types

Class B – *Oncidiinae* – Equitant Types

Class D – *Oncidiinae* – Any other type

Section 6 – *Paphiopedilum* and *Phragmipedium* Hybrids

Class A – *Paphiopedilum* Standard types

Class B – *Paphiopedilum* Maudiae Type

Class C – *Paphiopedilum* Multiflowered Type – (e.g. St Swithin/Rothschildiana etc. types – minimum 2 open flowers – Excluding Class D

Class D – *Paphiopedilum* Hybrid Multifloral – Excluding Class C

Class E – *Paphiopedilum* Hybrid – Single Flower not included in Classes B and Class F

Class F – *Paphiopedilum* Hybrid

Class G – *Phragmipedium* Hybrid

Champion *Paphiopedilum/Phragmipedium* Hybrid

Section 7 – Any Other Genera Hybrid (excluding Section B)

Class A – *Spathoglottis* Hybrid

Class B – Any Other Genus Hybrid

Section 8 – Australian Hybrids

(All species in the registered parentage MUST occur naturally in Australia or Territories under the political control of Australia. In this context when the species *Dendrobium phalaenopsis* is listed in parentage it is considered to be the species from Timor and NOT native to Australia)

Class A – Dendrobiums – any colour or markings

Class B – Any other Genus – any colour or markings

Section 9 – Australiana Species

(All species MUST occur naturally in Australia or Territories under the political control of Australia. In this context the species *Dendrobium phalaenopsis* is considered to be the species from Timor and NOT native to Australia.

Class A – Dendrobiums – any colour or markings

Class B – Any other Genus – any colour or markings

Section 10 – Exotic Species

(All species MUST NOT occur naturally in Australia or Territories under the political control of Australia. Should a species occur naturally both Australia and another country, it is to be included in Section 9)

Class A – *Laeliinae*

Class C – *Vandae* – not included in Class D

Class D – *Phalaenopsis/Doritis*

Class E – *Oncidiinae*

Class F – *Paphiopedilum*

Class G – *Phragmipedium*

Class H – Any Other Species Orchid not listed above.

Should any Class see more than 4 of any Genus (e.g. <i>Rhynchostylis</i>) a special class may be created. Class D/A etc.
